

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MUNDY**

**ORDINANCE NO. 92-T**

**AN ORDINANCE TO REDUCE THE BASIC MINIMUM FEE FOR  
SANITARY SEWER SERVICE FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AT THEIR  
PRIMARY RESIDENCE EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2008.**

**THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MUNDY ORDAINS:**

**SECTION I**

**APPLICABILITY**

A. All Township residents, or their spouse, who are at least 62 years of age, shall be entitled and are granted a ten percent (10%) reduction of the basic minimum sewer usage fee for their primary residence. This shall become effective upon application being made by such resident who meets the requirements of this Ordinance.

B. Proof of age, residency and homestead status shall be provided to the Treasurer's office before the granting of such rate reduction contained herein.

**SECTION II**

**DEFINITIONS**

A. A "Township resident" is defined as a person who has a legal residence within Mundy Township, where they primarily reside.

B. "Primary personal residence" is defined as the location where the State of Michigan recognizes as a homestead and the premises are granted a principal homestead exemption for real estate tax purposes. This shall not include any business or commercial application.

**SECTION III**

**SEVERABILITY**

Should any portion of this Ordinance be held invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed as affecting the validity of any of the remaining portions.

**SECTION IV**

**EFFECTIVE DATES OF ORDINANCE**

A. This Ordinance and the provisions contained herein shall become effective upon passage and publication.

B. The provisions of this Ordinance are effective November 1, 2008. The utilization of the adjusted fee schedule contained herein shall only become effective after application is made by the resident for a period not to be any earlier than the date of the application for the adjusted rate.
